NAHA is currently working towards obtaining mutual certification from BPJPH.

The mutual certification review with Indonesia was carried out from September 25th to 27th. We attach a commemorative photo of the review. After that, we have signed a preliminary agreement at the H20 event in Jakarta. At this time, we are waiting for the decision from Indonesia.

Originally, under Indonesian law, all imported foods had to be halal by October 17th, 2024. However, because of the time required for mutual certification with the rest of the world, the deadline has been extended to October 17th, 2026.

We will contact you as soon as we receive the decision on the mutual certification. Thank you in advance.

"The obligation to have halal certification for food products, beverages, slaughtered products, and slaughtering services originating from abroad is determined by the Minister no later than October 17, 2026 after considering the completion of cooperation on mutual recognition of Halal Certificates."
